The House Committee on Small Business will hold a markup of legislation at **9:45 AM ET on Tuesday, November 18, 2025**, in room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building. The following seven measures will be considered:

1. **H.R. 5763** – Main Street Parity Act
2. **H.R. 5788** – 504 Program Risk Oversight Act
3. **H.R. 3496** – Northern Mariana Islands Small Business Access Act
4. **H.R. 5764** – AI for Mainstreet Act
5. **H.R. 5784** – Artificial Intelligence Wisdom for Innovative Small Enterprises (AI-WISE) Act
6. **H.R. 5778** – Improving SBA Engagement on Employee Ownership Act
7. **H.R. 4305** – Destroying Unnecessary, Misaligned, and Prohibitive (DUMP) Red Tape Act of 2025

Any Member wishing to submit an amendment for consideration must provide the Committee with a written form no later than 24 hours prior to the markup to the attention of Colin Hall, Committee Clerk (colin.hall@mail.house.gov). Members are encouraged to work with Legislative Counsel and Committee staff in drafting their amendments. While Members may file amendments, in writing, at any time prior to or during the markup, the Chair prefers amendments to be pre-filed. This will enable all Members to have sufficient time to review the amendments. Please be aware of the following:

- Amendments filed 24 hours prior to the markup will be given priority consideration at the markup.
- The Chairman may refuse a unanimous consent request to consider the amendment as read if it is not filed and in compliance with the 24-hour prior deadline.
- Amendments filed after the deadline may not be distributed to Members until the start of the markup.

- Amendments drafted and offered after the commencement of the markup may necessitate the Chair recessing the markup to enable Committee staff to copy and distribute such amendments.
- All amendments must be in writing.
