2 (a) PAYCHECK PROTECTION PROGRAM.—Section
3 7(a)(36) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
4 636(a)(36)) is amended by adding at the end the following
5 new subparagraph:

6 "(W) FRAUD ENFORCEMENT HARMONI-7 ZATION.—Notwithstanding any other provision 8 of law, any criminal charge or civil enforcement 9 action alleging that a borrower engaged in 10 fraud with respect to a covered loan guaranteed 11 under this paragraph shall be filed not later 12 than 10 years after the offense was committed.". 13

(b) PAYCHECK PROTECTION PROGRAM SECOND
DRAW LOANS.—Section 7(a)(37) of the Small Business
Act (15 U.S.C. 636(a)(37)) is amended by adding at the
end the following new subparagraph:

18 "(P) FRAUD ENFORCEMENT HARMONI-19 ZATION.—Notwithstanding any other provision 20 of law, any criminal charge or civil enforcement 21 action alleging that a borrower engaged in 22 fraud with respect to a covered loan guaranteed 23 under this paragraph shall be filed not later 24 than 10 years after the offense was com-25 mitted.".
