

Other Federal Disaster Assistance

USDA

The Department of Agriculture offers:

- Food relief to victims impacted by storm
- Disaster SNAP benefits to those who need assistance purchasing food after a disaster
- Financial Assistance to landowners, farmers, ranchers, and producers for damages to crops, livestock, land, and businesses

VA

The Department of Veterans' Affairs assists victims with:

- Medical Assistance
- Burial Assistance
- Priority in acquiring VA-owned property in the case of displacement

HUD

The Department of Housing and Urban Development offers:

- Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery Assistance
- Mortgage Assistance

DHS

The Department of Homeland Security coordinates with FEMA to offer:

- Disaster Legal Services
- Emergency Family Registry and Locator System

DOL

The Department of Labor coordinates with FEMA to offer unemployment benefits to those individuals that find themselves out of work after a disaster

HHS

The Department of Health & Human Services offers:

- Disaster Resources for Older Adults & People w/ Disabilities
- Emergency Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services

Treasury

The Internal Revenue Service offers disaster assistance & emergency relief for individuals and businesses.
