

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT TO THE

Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. 6007. PROHIBITION ON INDIVIDUALS CONVICTED OF**
2 **CERTAIN MISDEMEANORS OR FELONIES**
3 **FROM RECEIVING CERTAIN ASSISTANCE.**

4 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

5 (1) the term “convicted of assaulting a police
6 officer” means being convicted of a misdemeanor or
7 felony under Federal or State law involving the as-
8 sault of a police officer;

9 (2) the term “convicted of a crime of violence”
10 means being convicted of a misdemeanor or felony
11 under Federal or State law that is a crime of vio-
12 lence;

13 (3) the term “convicted of a nonconsensual sex
14 offense” means being convicted of a felony under
15 Federal or State law that relates to a nonconsensual
16 sexual act; and

17 (4) the term “covered SBA assistance” means
18 a guarantee of a covered loan under paragraph (36)
19 or (37) of section 7(a) of the Small Business Act

1 (15 U.S.C. 636(a)), a loan or guarantee made under
2 section 7(b)(2) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
3 636(b)(2)), or an advance under section 1110(e) of
4 the CARES Act (15 U.S.C. 9009(e)).

5 (b) PROHIBITION.—The Administrator of the Small
6 Business Administration may not provide any covered
7 SBA assistance to an individual, or a business concern
8 owned or controlled by an individual, who was convicted
9 of a nonconsensual sex offense, convicted of a crime of
10 violence, or convicted of assaulting a police officer during
11 the 5-year period ending on the date on which the covered
12 SBA assistance would, but for this subsection, be pro-
13 vided.
