The Committee on Small Business will hold a hybrid markup of legislation to amend the Small Business Act. The markup will be held at **10:00 A.M. (ET) on Wednesday, May 11, 2022, in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building and on Zoom**. Members who wish to participate remotely may do so via Zoom, information to be provided separately. The items that will be marked up include:

- H.R. 7352, “PPP and Bank Fraud Enforcement Harmonization Act of 2022”
- H.R. 7334, “COVID-19 EIDL Fraud Statute of Limitations Act of 2022”
- H.R. 7622, “Small Business Workforce Pipeline Act of 2022”
- H.R. 7664, “Supporting Small Business and Career and Technical Education Act of 2022”
- H.R. 7670, “Women-Owned Small Business Program Transparency Act”
- H.R. 5879, “Hubzone Price Evaluation Preference Clarification Act of 2021”
- H.R. 7694, “Strengthening Subcontracting for Small Businesses Act of 2022”

Members are encouraged to work with the House Office of the Legislative Counsel (HOLC) and Committee staff in drafting their amendments. Any Member wishing to submit an amendment for consideration should file with the Clerk of the Committee by emailing them to the amendment repository at SBCDocuments@mail.house.gov. Only 1 amendment may be submitted per email. The email should include the following:

- 1) The sponsor of the amendment;
- 2) The measure (bill, resolution, etc.) being amended; and
- 3) A 1-2 sentence factual description of the amendment.

While Members may file amendments at any time prior to or during the markup, the Chair strongly encourages Members to file their amendments at least 24 hours prior to the commencement of the markup.

Please be aware that:

- Amendments filed prior to the deadline will be given priority consideration at the markup.
- The Chairwoman may refuse a unanimous consent request to consider the amendment as read if it is not filed before the deadline.
- Amendments filed after the deadline may not be distributed to Members until the markup.
- All amendments must be in writing.
- Any amendments filed after the deadline may necessitate the Chair to either informally pause the markup or recess the markup subject to the call of the Chair.
