The Committee on Small Business Subcommittee on Innovation and Workforce Development will meet for a hearing titled, "Putting America Back to Work: The Role of Workforce Development and Small Business Rehiring." The hearing is scheduled to begin at 1:00 P.M. on Thursday, July 16, 2020, via webcast and dial-in (information to be provided).

Since March, over 45 million Americans have applied for unemployment and some experts estimate that many of these jobs will not return. This hearing will analyze federal programs intended to develop the nation's workforce and allow Members to hear from experts and officials about how to put Americans back to work.
