1	SEC. 2. EMPLOYMENT SIZE STANDARD REQUIREMENTS.
2	(a) In General.—Section 3(a)(2) of the Small Busi-
3	ness Act (15 U.S.C. 632(a)(2)) is amended—
4	(1) in subparagraph (A), by inserting "and sub-
5	ject to the requirements specified under subpara-
6	graph (C)" after "paragraph (1)"; and
7	(2) in subparagraph (C)—
8	(A) by inserting "(including the Adminis-
9	tration when acting pursuant to subparagraph
10	(A))" after "no Federal department or agency";
11	and
12	(B) in clause (ii)(I) by striking "12
13	months" and inserting "24 months".
14	(b) Effective Date.—This Act and the amend-
15	ments made by this Act shall take effect one year after
16	the date of the enactment of this Act.
