A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to clarify the application of the price evaluation preference for qualified HUBZone small business concerns to certain contracts, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Hubzone Price Evalua-
5 tion Preference Clarification Act of 2021”.

1 **SEC. 2. APPLICATION OF PRICE EVALUATION PREFERENCE**
2 **FOR QUALIFIED HUBZONE SMALL BUSINESS**
3 **CONCERNS TO CERTAIN CONTRACTS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 31(c)(3) of the Small
5 Business Act (15 U.S.C. 657a(c)(3)) is amended by add-
6 ing at the end the following new subparagraph:

7 “(E) APPLICATION TO CERTAIN CON-
8 TRACTS.—The requirements of subparagraph
9 (A) shall apply to an unrestricted order issued
10 under an unrestricted multiple award contract
11 or the unrestricted portion of a contract that is
12 partially set aside for competition restricted to
13 small business concerns.”.

14 (b) RULEMAKING.—Not later than 90 days after the
15 date of the enactment of this section, the Administrator
16 of the Small Business Administration shall revise any rule
17 or guidance to implement the requirements of this section.
